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Citrix Virtual Apps and Desktops 7 Advanced Administration

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QUESTION 1

Scenario: A Citrix Engineer is maintaining a Citrix Virtual Apps environment. The engineer has recently noticed two single-threaded applications consistently consuming 25% of the CPU resources, causing substantial performance issues for users of these servers. The engineer has deployed Workspace Environment Management (WEM) within the infrastructure and enabled CPU Spikes Protection.

What else can the engineer enable within WEM to address this issue?

- A. Exclude Specified Processes and add the two problem applications
- B. Process Affinity and add the two problem applications
- C. CPU Clamping and set it to 10% for the two problem applications
- D. Limit Sample Time and set it to 10% for the two problem applications

Correct Answer: C

QUESTION 2

What are two valid options to manage antivirus definition updates in a Citrix App Layering deployment? (Choose two.)

- A. Enable auto-updates and store updates in the Elastic Layer assigned to each user.
- B. Disable auto-updates and redeploy the layer for each update on a schedule approved by the security team.
- C. Enable auto-updates and store updates in the user's User Layer.
- D. Disable auto-updates and clear the checkbox for "Reinstall the layer" when redeploying the layers.

Correct Answer: BC

Explanation: Turn on auto updates, and let the updates get stored in the user's Personalization Layer. If auto updates happen daily, this might be the most convenient approach. Note that whenever there is a major product update, you'll need to reinstall on the UEP by redeploying the layer to the desktop with the Reinstall the layer checkbox selected. Turn off auto updates, and redeploy the layer for each update. This requires updating the layer whenever you want to push out new updates.

A Citrix Engineer wants to enable the "Log Off Web Portal When Session is Launched" feature within Workspace Environment Management (WEM) transformer settings.

What does the engineer need to do prior to enabling this feature?

- B. Set Workspace control settings to log off from session when users log off from StoreFront.

- C. Set Workspace control to automatically reconnect to the sessions when users log onto StoreFront.
- D. Set Workspace control settings to NOT log off a session when users log off from StoreFront.

QUESTION 5

Which two considerations are accurate regarding the Process Management feature of Workspace Environment Management (WEM)? (Choose two.)

- A. When WhiteList is enabled, any process NOT added to the BlackList will be automatically whitelisted
- B. When using exclusions for either Local Administrators or Specified Groups, it is available for Process Blacklist, but NOT for Process WhiteList
- C. When WhiteList is enabled, any process NOT added to the WhiteList will be automatically blacklisted
- D. When adding application processes to either the BlackList or the WhiteList, they need to be designated by the full executable name
