- H. A connection to the target database instance is always required.

You execute the following piece of code with appropriate privileges:

Correct Answer: AC

Note:

DBMS\_REDACT.FULL completely redacts the column data.

DBMS\_REDACT.NONE applies no redaction on the column data. Use this function for development testing purposes. LOB columns are not supported.

The DBMS REDACT package provides an interface to Oracle Data Redaction, which enables you to mask (redact) data that is returned from gueries issued by low-privileged users or an application.

If you create a view chain (that is, a view based on another view), then the Data Redaction policy also applies throughout this view chain. The policies remain in effect all of the way up through this view chain, but if another policy is created for one of these views, then for the columns affected in the subsequent views, this new policy takes precedence.

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"Specifies that the backup or copy never becomes obsolete (see Example 2-27). A recovery catalog is required when FOREVER is specified because the backup records eventually age out of the control file."

"Execute CREATE SCRIPT only at the RMAN prompt. RMAN must be connected to a target database and a recovery catalog."

This subclause specifies a point in time as a time, SCN, or log sequence number. You must be connected to a recovery catalog when issuing a REPORT SCHEMA command with an AT clause."

#### **QUESTION 4**
