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QUESTION 1

An administrator has purchased WildFire subscriptions for 90 firewalls globally. What should the administrator consider with regards to the WildFire infrastructure?

- A. To comply with data privacy regulations, WildFire signatures and verdicts are not shared globally.
- B. Palo Alto Networks owns and maintains one global cloud and four WildFire regional clouds.
- C. Each WildFire cloud analyzes samples and generates malware signatures and verdicts independently of the other WildFire clouds.
- D. The WildFire Global Cloud only provides bare metal analysis.

Correct Answer: C

Each WildFire cloud--global (U.S.), regional, and private--analyzes samples and generates WildFire verdicts independently of the other WildFire clouds. With the exception of WildFire private cloud verdicts, WildFire verdicts are shared globally, enabling WildFire users to access a worldwide database of threat data.

QUESTION 2

A superuser is tasked with creating administrator accounts for three contractors. For compliance purposes, all three contractors will be working with different device-groups in their hierarchy to deploy policies and objects. Which type of role-based access is most appropriate for this project?

- A. Create a Dynamic Admin with the Panorama Administrator role
- B. Create a Custom Panorama Admin
- C. Create a Device Group and Template Admin
- D. Create a Dynamic Read only superuser

Correct Answer: C

A Custom Panorama Admin is a type of role-based access that allows a super user to create separate Panorama administrator accounts for each of the three contractors. This will allow each contractor to work with different device-groups in their hierarchy and deploy policies and objects in accordance with the organization's compliance requirements. The Custom Panorama Admin role also allows the super user to assign separate permissions to each contractor's account, granting them access to only the resources they are authorized to use. This type of role-based access is the most appropriate for this project as it will ensure that each contractor is only able to access the resources they need in order to do their job.

Which virtual router feature determines if a specific destination IP address is reachable?

- D. Ping-Path
